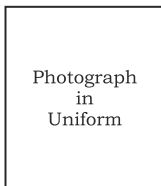

AIMS & OBJECTIVES

Convent of Our Lady of Providence Girls High School started in 1947 by the sisters, Franciscan Missionaries of Mary. This Christian Minority School was begun with primary objective of providing education in a Christian atmosphere to all children, especially Christians.

The main aim of the school is to enable the students to know and develop their physical, mental, social, moral and spiritual potentialities based on the principles of Christian faith.

The motto of the school **“To Love through Truth”** is the ideal set before our staff and students, in order that their thoughts, words, and actions may be motivated each day by love and truth.

We strive to promote patriotism, spirit of national integration, pride in our cultural outlook, fellowship, team spirit, and value education is given its importance along with intellectual pursuit.

PROMOTION AND WITHDRAWAL

1. There will be two unit tests and a Half Yearly Examination and attendance for these, is compulsory. Promotion is granted on the basis of the year's work together with the Final examination. No further examination will be held, the result being final.

The students of class I, II, III & IV will be promoted on the basis of regular academic performance in the class, assessed through the year.

2. **On the days when tests are held, attendance for the FULL DAY is essential. Students will NOT be permitted just to do the test and return home.**
3. **If the child is unwell, she should stay at home. Parents should send their daughter only if she can stay in School for the full day, or else she will not be permitted to do the unit test/assignment.**
4. **Special arrangement cannot be made for pupils who for any reason whatsoever, are absent from the test/unit test/main examination. No retest/reexam/assignment will be conducted for absentees.**
5. A student who uses unfair means during unit tests/examination will be given zero in that subject. Repetition of the same will result in stern action.
6. Students are not permitted to take study leave before unit test/examination, unless study leave has been sanctioned by the Principal. Marks will be deducted from those who are absenting themselves without prior permission.
7. Parent-Teacher Meetings are held periodically to assess the performance of the students. Should a parent desire to meet a teacher at any other time he/she may do so, by appointment. A teacher is also free to send for a parent in connection with the progress of a child, should she feel the need to do so. A student who fails twice in the same class will not be permitted to continue her studies in the school.
8. A month's notice must be given in writing by parents or guardians before the student is withdrawn, otherwise the fees for the current month will be charged. No Transfer Certificate will be issued until all fees due to the school are paid. The certificate will be issued 3 days after receipt of the application.
9. Examination and Promotion depends on child's performance throughout the year, weekly assessments unit tests half yearly and annual exams.

GENERAL RULES

1. Special attention is given to ensure high standard of education. Parents are requested to co-operate with the school authorities in maintaining order and discipline by insisting on regular attendance and punctuality from their children.
2. Attendance in assembly is compulsory for all. Pupils must be in full uniform according to the curriculum. Uniform must be neat and tidy.
3. Pupils who have been absent from class must bring a letter from the parents stating the cause of absence in the space provided in this diary. In case of illness exceeding three days, a Medical Certificate must be submitted along with a letter, which should be addressed to the Principal. No pupil is allowed to leave the School premises without the permission of the Principal.
4. The child's name will be struck off the roll, if she is absent for more than 3 months. In such case re-admission is necessary. Parents/Guardians must come in person to inform the office the cause for the long absence in writing.
5. 80% attendance is compulsory to appear for the Annual Examination. Pupils who are not present on the last day and the reopening day of any vacation (Summer, Puja and Christmas) are liable to face disciplinary actions.
6. Parents should inform the school authorities if their child is suffering from any serious illness, chronic ailment, physical handicap or Sensory defect (e.g. heart disorder or epilepsy). Children who are suffering from Eye flu, Chicken Pox, mumps or any other contagious diseases are strictly forbidden to attend the school without a fitness certificate.
7. Parents/Guardians are requested to notify the Principal of change of address or telephone number, within three days.

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8. Parents are also requested not to engage class teachers or subject teachers for private tuition.
 9. Parents are informed that the occasional remarks from the teachers are conveniently sent through the pages of the school diary and are encouraged to do like-wise. They are requested to check this diary daily.
 10. Parents are requested to prepare their children for all the activities.
 11. Parents are asked not to unduly pressurise the child at home.
 12. An identity card with a photograph of the student in school uniform must be presented to every person collecting their wards from school. Pupils must put their identity cards daily.
 13. No pupil may leave the school premises during school hours or recess without the prior permission of the Principal.
 14. Children are forbidden to wear jewellery, put mehendi, nail polish or apply hair colour in school. Strict action will be taken against the defaulters. Plucking of eyebrows not allowed.
 15. No gifts are allowed on birthdays. Children are allowed to share only toffees on their birthday.
 16. Damage to school property by pupils will be chargeable to parents / guardian.
 17. Pupils are responsible for maintaining a clean environment in school.
 18. Parents / Guardians are not allowed to gift anything to the teachers without a prior permission from the Principal.
 19. Mobile phones are prohibited in the school premises. If caught, mobile will be confiscated. Toys and fancy items will be confiscated.

- (a) Parents to sign report cards. circulars and attend PTM When requested.
 - (b) Visiting malls clubs, or movies in school uniform to be forbidden.
20. Objectionable literature in the form of books, magazines, newspaper etc. is strictly forbidden in the school.
21. Books, exercise books are to be taken from the school only.
22. Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, disobedience and bad conduct in the school, are sufficient reasons for the suspension of a pupil.

1. Fees is payable for twelve calendar months in the year. Fees may be increased according to the discretion of the Governing Body of the School.
 2. All fees must be paid to the **SCHOOL OFFICE** Monday to Friday (8.45 a.m. to 11.30 a.m.). No fees collection on Saturday.
 3. Part payment of fees for any month will not be accepted.
 4. All fees must be paid in **CASH**.
 5. Fees should be paid by the **15th of the month** failing which a **Late fee of Rs. 50/-** will be charged per month.
 6. Pupils whose fees have not been paid on time may be barred from sitting for the assessments and examinations.

CURRICULUM

The medium of instruction is English.

The pupils are prepared for Madhyamik Pariksha, West Bengal .

In addition to the subjects prescribed in the Board, The curriculum includes Religious Instructions (for Christians) and Value Educations (for people of other faith) as compulsory subjects.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Co-Curricular Activities are of paramount importance. Inter-personal skills, confidence, poise and reliability are some of the qualities developed through co-curricular activities. Hence, such activities are an essential part of the school programme.

These activities include debates, elocution, art and craft, dramatics quiz, yoga, singing, dancing, physical training, needle-work, basket ball, kabaddi and kho-kho, etc.
